The Solomons Island Yacht Club (SIYC), established in 1937, is one of the oldest yacht clubs on the Chesapeake Bay and boasts a long heritage of service to the community, including sponsorship of the annual Light Parade and ongoing support for the Waterman's Festival.

Newly-elected Commodore Robert Kuzmick and his wife Nancy are proud to discuss the history of the SIYC and the many friends the club has made over the years, pointing to 357 burgees from 30 states and 34 foreign countries. Despite its international renown, most of its members live within a 150-mile radius of Solomons. At least 50% of the members are active boaters.

Thanks to reasonable membership fees and yearly dues, the SIYC membership is around 200, with 70 currently on an approximately 5-year waiting list.

### Amaretto Glazed Shrimp

- 10 Jumbo Shrimp
- 3 oz Heavy Cream
- 3 oz Unsalted Butter
- 4 oz Amaretto

In a shallow pan add heavy cream, butter and Amaretto. Bring to a boil. Butterfly the jumbo shrimp. Reduce the sauce down. Add the shrimp and toss until the shrimp are fully cooked and glazed. Serve with your favorite rice and seasonal vegetable.

The boats are equipped to handle from 13 to 49 passengers and are available for fishing charters, private parties and cruises, including a 3½-hour dinner cruise on the Patuxent River at sunset (in conjunction with Clarke's Landing Restaurant – select dates in September, October and November only).

Rockfish Trophy Season is Bunky's busiest time of the year. From Sunday, April 17th through Sunday, May 15th, licensed anglers are allowed to keep one catch of 28 inches or longer. There will be a mad rush to get back out on the water, so reserve your spot, rental or charter now.

**From Washington D.C.** Take the Capital Beltway (I-495/I-95) to Route 4 (Exit 11 south) Pennsylvania Ave. Follow Route 4 south approx. 50 miles to Dowell Rd., just before Solomons Island. Left on Dowell Rd. to The Harbours on the right.

**From Annapolis, MD:** Take Route 2 (Solomons Island Rd) south to merge with Route 4 South. Stay on Route 4 to Dowell Rd., just before Solomons Island. Turn left on Dowell Rd. to The Harbours at Solomons Island.
